



# Onore-sho Calligraphy Workshop for Foreigners

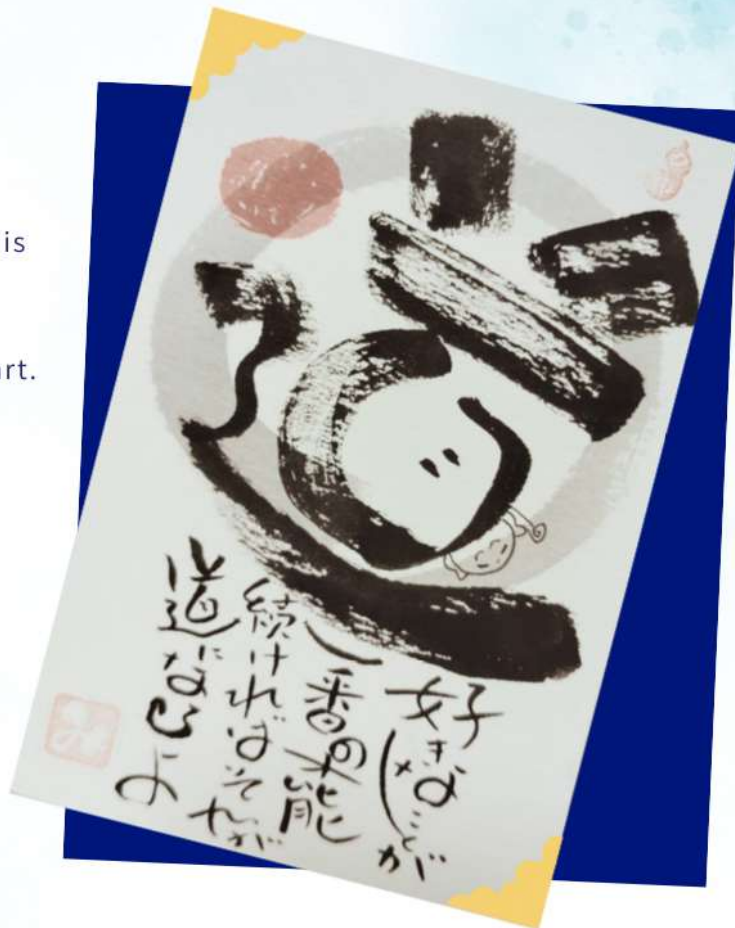


## What is Onore-sho
