## 4. Applying for Alien Registration (GAIKOKUJIN TOUROKU)

(1) If you are of foreign nationality residing in Japan for more than 90 days, please apply for alien registration at your local city hall.

In Toyohashi, alien registrations are processed within city hall, west wing, 1st floor (Citizens Registry Division - Alien Registration Desk).

Please apply in person (Children under 16 and newborns may be registered by a family member with whom they live).

\* Photographs must have been taken within the last 6 months (4.5cm high × 3.5cm wide) face forward, head uncovered, plain background from the chest up.

(2) Please apply for a change in registration in the following cases If you move to another municipality, please reapply at your new local public office.

## (3) Applying for renewal, exchange or re-issuance

Your Alien Registration Card must be renewed periodically to check if it is up to date. If your card is lost, stolen, or somehow damaged, please apply for an exchange or re-issuance of your card.

Please apply in person (Children under 16 may be registered by a family member over the age of 16 may apply for them).

(4) Alien Registration Cards must be returned in the following cases:

Death

Please return the card to city hall within 14 days of death.

Leaving Japan

Unless you have received a Re-Entry Permit, please return your Alien Registration Card at the airport (port) of your departure.
